phrase: sözcük takımı

runner.

tray: tepsi

jam: reçel, marmelat

There is a jar of strawberry jam on the table.

**muffin:** küçük tatlı kek I like blueberry *muffins*.

croissant: ay şeklinde küçük ekmek, çörek, krosan

I sometimes eat *croissant* for lunch.

bread: ekmek

This bread is fresh/stale.

**cereal:** tahıl gevreği, gevrek I have <u>cereal</u> for breakfast.

sausage: sosis

Grilled sausage is my favourite.

blueberry: böğürtlen

My sister doesn't like blueberries.

pancake: krep, gözleme, ince çörek

Do you want a sweet pancake or a savoury one?

butter: tereyağı

Put some *butter* on the crackers, please.

preference: tercih, yeğleme

Her  $\underline{\textit{preference}}$  is for comfortable rather than stylish clothes.

omelette: omlet

I prefer cheese *omelette* to mushroom one.

bean: fasulye

She grows her own beans.

toast: kızarmış ekmek dilimi

I have toast and marmalade for breakfast.

hungry: aç, acıkmış

I am hungry. What's for supper?

**nutritious:** besleyici Raw spinach is *nutritious*. useful: faydalı, yararlı

Do the exercises serve any useful purpose?

health: sağlık, sıhhat

Regular exercise is good for your *health*.

calcium: kalsiyum

There is *calcium* in teeth and bones.

enjoy: hoşlanmak, sevmek, zevk almak

I hope you *enjoy* your meal.

thirsty: susamış I'm really <u>thirsty.</u>

**conversation:** konuşma, sohbet The <u>conversation</u> is about football.

speech: konuşma

She gives a *speech* on the economy.

waiter: erkek garson You are a waiter at a café.

customer: müşteri, alıcı

Mrs Wilson is one of our regular *customers*.

**order:** sipariş, ısmarlama Can I take your <u>order</u> now?
