

## DREAMS 7<sup>th</sup> GRADE VOCABULARY

**dream:** rüya, hayal – rüya görmek, hayal etmek/kurmak  
It was his **dream** to become an actor.

**origami:** (Japon) kağıt katlama sanatı

**Origami** is the Japanese art of folding paper into attractive shapes.

**blue bead:** mavi boncuk, nazar boncuğu

People believe **blue beads** will protect them from evil eyes.

**predict:** tahmin etmek, önceden kestirmek/söylemek

You cannot **predict** the weather with absolute accuracy.

**future:** gelecek, ati, istikbal

They hope to get married in the near **future** (=soon).

**company:** 1-şirket, kuruluş, ortaklık 2-arkadaşlık, eşlik

He works for a software **company**.

**possible:** mümkün, imkan dahilinde

Is it **possible** to buy tickets in advance?

**tape:** teyp, kaset/kaydetmek

If you give me a blank **tape** I'll record it for you.

**hit:** vurmak, dürtmek, çarpmak

She **hit** him on the head with her tennis racket.

**prediction:** tahmin, öngörü, önceden kestirme

Let me get your **predictions** on the final score.

**receive:** (teslim) almak

She **received** a number of awards during her lifetime.

**lie:** yalan söylemek/yazmak

He **lied** about his qualifications for the job.

**probably:** muhtemelen, olasılıkla

I'll **probably** be home by midnight.

**excellent:** çok iyi, mükemmel

That was an **excellent** meal.

**guess:** tahmin etmek, kestirmeye çalışmak

Can you **guess** how old he is?

**certainly:** kesinlikle, tabii, elbette

Their team **certainly** deserved to win.

**price:** fiyat, bedel, karşılık

House **prices** are rising.

**imagine:** hayal etmek, tasavvur etmek, gözünde canlandırmak

I **imagine** (that) he's under a lot of pressure at the moment.

**peaceful:** sakin, huzur dolu, barış içinde

He had a **peaceful** life.

**become:** bir şey olmaya başlamak, olmak

They **became** great friends.

**disappear:** gözden kaybolmak, sırta kadem basmak

Her husband **disappeared** in 1991.

**freedom:** özgürlük, bağımsızlık

You have the **freedom** to do what you want to do.

**trouble:** sorun, güçlük, problem, endişe

We had **trouble** finding somewhere to park.

**enemy:** düşman, hasım

The cat uses its claws to protect itself against **enemies**.

**nightmare:** kabus, korkulu rüya, karabasan

He still has **nightmares** about the accident.

**interpreter:** mütercim, tercüman, çevirmen

She acted as **interpreter** for us.

**exchange:** değiş tokuş etmek, başka bir ürünle değiştirmek

Can I **exchange** this shirt for a larger size?

**have a word with someone:** biriyle sohbet etmek

Can I **have a word with you**?

**pass:** (sınav/test) geçmek, başarmak

I **passed** my driving test the first time.

**worry:** kaygılanmak, endişelenmek

Don't **worry** – she'll be all right.

**definitely:** kuşkusuz, kesinlikle

This book is **definitely** worth reading.

**flap:** 1-kanatlı kapak/örtü 2- çırpma, sallama

The curtains were **flapping** around in the breeze.

**soon:** birazdan, yakında, çok geçmeden

It's too **soon** to make a decision.

**breathe:** nefes alıp vermek, solumak

Doctors gave him oxygen to help him **breathe**.

**quote:** alıntı, aktarma, iktibas (yapmak)

He **quoted** from Shakespeare.

**wonderful:** şahane, harikulâde, çok güzel

We had a **wonderful** time in Spain.

**perfect:** mükemmel, kusursuz, tam istendiği gibi

Her performance was **perfect**.

**belonging(s):** şahsi eşya(lar)

I took a few personal **belongings** with me.

**look after:** bakmak, bakımını üstlenmek, ilgilenmek

Could you **look after** the children while I'm out?

**expectation:** umut, beklenti

My parents had high **expectations** for me.

**environment:** çevre

The new road may cause damage to the **environment**.

**language:** dil, lisan

How many **languages** do you speak?

**fair:** adil, hakkaniyetli

That's not **fair**. You always go first!

**through:** in/in içinden; ..dan/den geçerek, boyunca, sayesinde

The River Seine flows **through** Paris.

**disease:** hastalık, rahatsızlık

She got a rare liver **disease** when she was only twenty.

**forever:** ebediyen, daima, sonsuza dek

After her death, their lives changed **forever**.

**scary:** korkutucu, ürkütücü, tedirgin eden

It was a really **scary** moment.

**temperature:** sıcaklık, ısı

Last night the **temperature** dropped to below freezing.

**strange:** yabancı, tuhaf, garip, acayip

She woke up in a **strange** bed in a **strange** room.

**following:** sonrasında, sonucunda, arkasından, akabinde

He dies on October 23<sup>rd</sup>, **following** several years of illness.

**journey:** yolculuk, gezi, seyahat

We take games for the children when we go on long **journeys**.

**task:** iş, görev, vazife, ödev

Our first **task** is to set up a communications system.
